Shortly after 1 p.m. Wednesday the Clinton Fire Department was advised of a chlorine leak from a bulk tank at the Henry County Water Plant on Coal Creek Road.

The fire department responded to the scene, along with Clinton Police Officers to assist in closing any effected area.

Upon arrival, firefighters found that a small leak was occurring from a valve on a bulk tank in the facility and, with the assistance of the plant employees, firefighters entered the building and quickly stopped the leak.

Thanks to the fast response from the employees at the water company the leak was very minimal and caused no injuries.
